

What is the difference between the Northwest Ohio Flood Mitigation Partnership and the Blanchard River Watershed Partnership?

- **The Blanchard River Watershed Partnership (BRWP)** is chartered by the State of Ohio to focus on the long-term, improvement of water quality within the region serviced by the watershed. To do this, the BRWP volunteers help as good stewards of the waterways in protecting and promoting water resources.
- **The North West Ohio Flood Mitigation Partnership (NWOFP)** was a private group, now disbanded, who was organized after the devastating 2007 Flood to find flooding reduction solutions and coordinate efforts between local, state and federal governments.

Note: While the NWOFP was in operation, both groups cooperated due to the resources BRWP could offer in assisting the flood mitigation planning, especially in the area of water quality and natural solutions it had already been developing.
