

What is the Source of Your Drinking Water?

- A carbonated bedrock aquifer serves as the primary source of groundwater for the **rural** population of the watershed. All rural areas in the watershed get their water from groundwater by way of private wells.
- The **City of Findlay** receives its water from two upground reservoirs located about 4 miles east the city. The water in the reservoirs is pumped into the reservoirs from the Blanchard River.
- The **Village of Ottawa** also pumps water from the Blanchard River into an upground reservoir.
- Ottawa supplies drinking water not only to the village, but also to the villages of **Glandorf, Bluffton and Miller City**.
- The villages of **Arlington, Beaverdam, Benton Ridge, Dunkirk, DuPont, Forest, Gilboa, Houcktown, Jenera, Mt Blanchard, Mt. Cory, Patterson, Rawson, Stark and Vanlue** receive their water from groundwater by way of private wells.
