OTTAWA CREEK WATERSHED REPORT CARD


Ottawa Creek watershed covers a very flat area. Ottawa Creek starts just north of CR. 27 between CR. 113 and TR. 56. The creek flows northward between Mt. Cory and Rawson before flowing into the Blanchard River between TR. 123 and SR. 235 just north of CR. 86. The bulk of the Ottawa Creek watershed lies west of this point. Moffitt Ditch, Dukes Run, and Dutch Run all form smaller watersheds that flow into the Blanchard River within the Ottawa Creek watershed. The southern boundary of the watershed in this area runs along CR. 24 in Hancock County and just south of the Allen/Putnam County line. The western boundary runs along a ridge just west of the Lower Riley Creek through Pandora northward along Road 7 in Putnam County. The northern boundary runs along TR. 90 in Hancock County and Road I in Putnam County.


